



**GVAA's Summer Art Show and Sale**  
**at Camino Real Marketplace**

Members of the Goleta Valley Art Association will have the opportunity to show and sell their works of art when the Association hosts

***The Summer Art Show and Sale at the Marketplace***

***Saturday, August 13, 2022***

***11 a.m.-5 p.m.***

This will be a non-juried exhibition, outdoors at Goleta's Camino Real Marketplace, where locals and tourists will be gathering to shop, eat and celebrate summer! If you would like to be a part of this exciting event, here are some guidelines for you to be thinking about...

**TGVAA will provide:**

- Panels may be reserved as single (one side of the pair) or double (both sides). See photo on the next page.
- Panels measuring 38 inches wide X 60- or 72-inches high are available. These will be \$35 for a single, one side, and \$70 for a double, both sides of the panels.
- Each artist may reserve no more than one double panel. If reserving a single panel, you may choose a panel partner ahead of time (be sure to tell us who) or someone may join you the day of the event to use the other side.

**Tables, chairs, umbrellas**

- GVAA will provide pop-up tents accommodating up to four artists each.

- Small tables will be allowed in order for artists to sell craft items (as we do for Picassos4Peanuts). Please note: the tables will NOT be able to be placed inside the tents, so keep this in mind when considering what you want to display.
- At the request of the Marketplace management, tables should be covered in the same color. GVAA will provide plastic table covers you can pick up when checking in if you bring a table in order to comply with this request.
- Please bring your own chair. Assistants, of course, are welcome but we need to limit the number of chairs per artist to two.

### **Artists:**

- **Fill out and submit the Artist Application attached.**
- Payment process:
  - Each artist will be provided a triplicate receipt book.
  - When a piece is sold, the artist will make out a receipt (legibly and pressing hard enough so copies are clear). ***Be sure to write your name on each receipt!***
  - Artist will give the white and pink copies to the customer to take to the cashier table.
  - Cashier will mark the pink copy paid and customer will present this to the artist and pick up the piece(s).
  - Cashier will keep the white copy for the organization.
  - At the end of the show, artists will tear out the (third) yellow copies to keep for their records and return the books to the cashier table for future use.
  - An accounting will be done as soon as possible and artists will receive checks by mail.
- A 25% commission will be deducted from the price to cover the costs of show and a donation to Direct Relief made as part of our agreement with the Marketplace.
- Participating artists should plan to arrive at Marketplace by 10 a.m. on August 13 to hang their work and art labels.
