A Message From Our President

Hard to believe the end of the year is near. So is our holiday season. GVAA has much to celebrate this year and much to look forward to in 2020.

So far in 2019, GVAA has had 7 scheduled shows which include ingatherings and

critiques at the Goleta Valley Library. We have our 8th show in November and the ingathering is November 1st. Our 9th and last show of 2019 will be our annual Picassos for Peanuts which hangs on Friday, December 6th with our reception on Saturday, December 7th. As usual, the Picassos for Peanuts show is not juried and our members are invited to bring what ever piece they would like to have in the show and it will be hung. The price for all pieces must be \$300 or less.

The Picassos for Peanuts reception which goes from 2:30-4:30 pm also includes a marketplace. Members are invited to bring cards, prints, jewelry, pottery, glass works etc for sale. The first who come will be the first served, so you will want to arrive by 2 pm so you can set up. Normally, we have 10 or 12 artists who share tables. We will have refreshments and holiday décor, so make sure you invite all your art lover friends to come and celebrate with us.

Following Picassos for Peanuts, we will have our Holiday Brunch on December 14, 11-1 pm. Once again, it will be at the Frog Bar & Grill at Glen Annie Golf Course. Plan to attend as we will have a wonderful time celebrating each other and our association. Non member guests are welcome. More information will follow.

In September, we hosted our 15th Annual Stow House Art Festival. Terre Sanitate, GVAA VP. was the head honcho and did a remarkable job coordinating all the various aspects. We had 460 guests in attendance who enjoyed Irish Music by the Decent Folk and the funky blues by The Summerland Band with Tom Henderson. The attendance was less than last year and we think the hot weather may have been a factor. Thank you to all the artists and artisans who participated and to those who volunteered during the Festival. Thank you Terre Sanitate!

At our last ingathering on September 27th, we invited people to bring in their used art materials for our Art Rummage Sale on Saturday, September 28th. Mary Peeters was our head honcho for this event and she did an outstanding job. Approximately 125 people attended and

purchased items. All proceeds go to benefit the Art After School Program at GUSD. Thank you Mary for your many years of handling this event.

It has been a full year with our Potluck Picnic at Stow Grove Park in July, several Art After School lessons offered to GUSD kids by our members and three workshops for our members. We had a Marketing workshop in April and two workshops with Golden Products. All workshops have been well attended.

In 2020, we again have 8 shows lined up with the library. We will have the same schedule as this year with ingatherings in January, February, June, July, August, September, November and December. The exact dates for ingatherings and critiques will be published soon. We will also be printing an Event Card for distribution to our members. It will have all pertinent dates, once all events have been scheduled.

JURYING AT GALLERY LOS OLIVOS



CALL TO ARTISTS

The Santa Barbara Public Library invites local artists to apply to be juried for month long solo shows in the Faulkner side galleries assigned by lottery for July 2020 through May 2021. The ingathering to jury local artists will be held on Saturday, November 16 from 10 - 12 in the main gallery of the Faulkner in the library. To apply, you must submit three 2-dimensional pieces of your artwork in any medium including photography that represent your style and ability to present your work for public gallery display. You are ineligible if you have had a solo show there since June 2018. There is no cost for applying, three jurors will select 20 applicants, and there is a cost to rent the side gallery for the month if you are selected. The sale took place on Saturday the 28th and was attended by approximately 125 people. The proceeds which go to benefit the Art After School program at Goleta Union School District totaled \$666.65. Thank you Mary Peeters and volunteer team. The raffle at the GVAA's Stow House Art Festival raised \$703 which also benefits the Art After School Program at GUSD. Thank you to those who sold and bought raffle tickets.

This totals \$1,369.65 and the GVAA board voted to add \$630.35 to make our annual contribution of \$2,000 to the program. This money will go to buy art supplies for the Art After School Program.
