Upcoming Events, Opportunities & Announcements

On Saturday, November 15, the Santa Barbara Public Library will hold an ingathering open to all local artists to apply for a month long solo show in one of the Faulkner Gallery side galleries. One or more artists can apply together for a month's show if you feel you do not have sufficient inventory by yourself but each artist must be juried. The jurors will select 20 artists for solo shows and the month will be selected by lottery from May 2015 through April 2016. This new approach will provide artists to fill the galleries for the next year and enable the library to then schedule this event annually every November which will make it more predictable to the artists.

This event is run by SBAA for the library and follows the same rules as the SBAA New Members ingathering **except** that it is limited to 2 dimensional artwork and **no application fee.** Bring in 3 pieces of 2 dimensional artwork ready for hanging, all in the same medium that represents your style. Three jurors evaluate your skill with the medium, your originality, and the way you present your work. You are not eligible to participate if you already have been assigned a show in the 12 months prior to May, 2015. You will need about 20 pieces to fill a side gallery and the artwork you display should be consistent with the 3 pieces you submitted, professionally framed and labeled. There is a \$150 fee for the month you are assigned to the gallery and an additional fee for any reception you may plan. If you have any questions, please call **Jacqui** at **564-7019**.


N O V E M B E R J U R O R
