

## TGVAA will provide:

- 48 panels measuring 38 inches wide X 60 or 72 inches high are available. These will be \$30 each and both sides of the panels are usable.
  - Each artist may reserve no more than two panels. If reserving one panel, you may choose a panel partner ahead of time (be sure to tell us who) or someone will join you the day of the event.
  - If reserving two panels, you will have four sides to utilize. (See illustration next page).
  - Works larger than 38 X 60 or 72 will not be eligible as all art must be installed on the panels.
- Art pieces that **can be hung on a panel** are welcome. This includes jewelry. You are welcome to bring a bin for prints, cards, bookmarks, etc.
- One chair will be provided per artist unless a second chair is requested. *No outside chairs will be allowed, and no tables will be allowed.*
- Panels will be allocated on a first-come, first-served basis the day of the event. Assistants are welcome; however, a maximum of two chairs per artist will be provided.

## Artists:

- Fill out and submit the Artist Application attached below.
- Participants agree to be present the day of the show. If you choose to have someone help you, TGVAA will provide an extra chair as noted above. You will need to provide this information at the time you reserve your panel(s).
- Payment process:
  - Label each painting with your Name, Title of Painting, Medium, Size and Price.
  - If the item is not a painting that can be labeled, provide another type of receipt for the buyer to take to the cashier.
  - Give the buyer the label/receipt to bring to the cashier - not the painting or other hanging work.
  - Buyer will receive a yellow and a pink sales slip which will allow them to collect the painting. Keep one copy.
- A 25% commission will be deducted from the price to cover the cost of the plaza and advertising of the show.
- Participating artists should plan to arrive at La Cumbre Plaza at 9 a.m. on August 21 to choose their panels, hang their work and art labels and lend a helping hand in setting up the show.

Panels may be reserved as single (one side of the pair) or double (as shown).



They can be covered in fabric so both sides can be used or left open for jewelry and other hanging items. For example: if you reserve one panel, you can use both sides of it.

If you reserved two panels, you will have four sides on which to hang your work.
